 - Pastor's Report October 2023

Since our last Session meeting, I have done the following:

- <u>Visits</u>: One with member at the manse.
 Home communion with Larry Roberson with Glenene and Donna
- Confirmation -- Found two dates for meetings so far: November 5 and 12.

- Continuing Education Time -- ***The Session voted to approve time off for the week of October 23 - 28 to attend Board of Pensions seminar on Retirement Planning. (Won't be taking a Sunday off at this time). I have already started (and almost completed) the homework required before attending this seminar.
 - O Will participate in required on-line Boundary Training on October 31 and November 1 from 3pm to 5:30 pm. I think there may be some homework required before and/or after the first session. In the past there was homework afterwards that was required to be turned in by a specific deadline, but I think they have discontinued that practice.
- Vacation -- Took a week vacation for my younger son's wedding in Colorado.
- Worship -- Facilitated communication about the Passing of the Peace experiment.
 - Led worship, including Communion on October 1st.
 - Working with the music staff to review hymn selections. We did not meet as a team this time.
 - Will start Advent worship planning soon.
- Manse -- Been in communication with Clark about repairing/replacing carpet in one of the
 guest rooms and vinyl flooring by garage door entrance that were damaged by the dog who
 had separation anxiety during the time that I was pet sitting. I received a quote and the
 Trustees will have met the day before session to decide next steps which I believe will be
 selecting the carpet and vinyl they want installed.
- Budget -- I will be requesting a portion of my salary in 2024 be designated as housing allowance. This will provide relief from having to pay employer and employee social security on the amount of money I spend on utilities and now, the manse repair expense. I may have the figure by session meeting, but I may not. This is essentially a bookkeeping matter.
- Oasis Grant -- The Synod is offering grants for pastoral leaders for things that will restore them not continuing education. The grants will be up to \$1,500 and priority will be given to Illinois pastoral leaders because the Indiana pastoral leaders have access to funding/grants through the Lilly Foundation that we do not. I will be asking for \$1,500 to cover some of the costs of my trainer who works with me on exercise and nutrition. My husband will be asking for money so that we can get away for an overnight once a quarter. We find that when we do get to see each other we jump right into home projects and never relax together. Since we've discovered that we don't get to vacation when the Peoria Beans do because we have to pet sit or babysit, finding an overnight once a quarter might be our best way to relax and reconnect.
- Covering for pastoral care -- I will be covering pastoral care for Rev. Marla Bauler October 12
 16.
- o **TRUSTEE'S REPORT:** September 2023
 - Projects completed:
 - Weeding, trimming and raking the Memory Garden.
 - Trimming bushes in front of manse, around the Church office and around the A/C.
 - Garbage can area cleaned and reorganized.
 - New aluminum flashing, roof repair and motion light on the basement exit.
 - New garage door opener for the manse.

- New timer and spotlights for the westside stained glass windows.
- Furnace filters changed.
- Furnaces set to heat and new times set for Sanctuary, CE Building and SS rooms.
- Batteries checked for smoke detectors.
- Otto Baum brick work completed above SS window eastside and holes filled on southside of office where heating exhaust vents were removed. The bill is paid.
- Snow removal set.
- Projects Planned:
 - No fall workday planned, as landscaping work done, and Tim will mow the leaves when they come down. A Spring 2024 cleanup day will remove those accumulated over the winter.
 - A Trustee work night is planned for November 8 at 6pm to clean and reorganize the room behind the choir loft.
 - Christmas Tree will be put up for Hanging of the Greens, which will be Sunday November 26, after worship.
 - Repair of trim around the basement SS window, eastside.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mission Study Committee: Bonnie asked Randy Welch to join and he declined. Beth will check again with Michelle Lane. Currently have Lissy Holder, Dale Benson and maybe Cindy Daniels on the Committee. Would like to have 4-5 people.
- Alissa and Missy would like to start a youth group. The Session voted to approve the use of the CE Building on evening of October 29 to attempt a first meeting.
- o The Mission Meal report is in the Christian Education section above. This is complete.
- o Celebration in CE Building for Daryl Phillips on Saturday, Oct. 21.
- Discussion and Visioning Time There have been some mixed comments on 'Passing the Peace' during worship. It was decided that it should be done after announcements. The Session voted to continue 'Passing the Peace' for the remainder of the year and then visit it again to decide whether to continue with it or not.

NEW BUSINESS:

- o It was noted that Advent starts on Sunday, December 3.
- Clerk attended 'Records Review' in Macomb on Thursday Sept. 14 from 9am-noon. The Minutes Book was approved through August 2023. There was also training where much was learned about what does and doesn't need to be included in minutes. Also, approval of things via text/email vote must be stated in the Bylaws and all requests need to go through the Moderator, who may ask the Clerk to send out the info to the Elders.
- A parishioner asked that a former Pastor be included in our Pulpit Supply contacts when the Interim Pastor is gone. There was discussion which included talking about other pulpit supply options, whether Presbytery policy/rules has changed (which will be confirmed), etc. There is an openness to considering this, but since there isn't a need before 2024, the Session agreed to pray and think about it until the next Session Meeting.

- The 2024 Church-Wide Mission Pledge Form was received. The Session voted to approve the same percentages as 2023, which is/recommendation has changed 52.5% to Presbytery of Great Rivers; 5% to Synod of Lincoln Trails; and 42.5% to General Assembly Mission Council. Clerk will complete the forms and send them in.
