Please pray for the work to begin in earnest towards calling a new minister. Pray for all those involved in education in our church. Please pray for the outreach and mission work. And please listen to see if God is calling you to further service here at First Presbyterian Church of Farmington, IL.

Snippets from the January 21 Session Meeting.

Once the meeting opened with prayer and a couple minor items taken care of, the meeting was suspended to allow for Deacon/Elder Training. Training started at 12:20pm with new Deacon Michelle Lane in attendance as well as some current Deacons. New Elders Cozy, Dale and Steffanie were also in attendance as well as several other sitting Elders. The Book of Order (BOO)was discussed, noting that you have power given by the BOO and should learn what is in it. Also went over the various Session Committees and what they cover. After some discussion, the Deacons, Michelle and Tammy Duley (via Phone) and the Elders, Cozy, Dale and Steffanie agreed to serve in their respective positions for the Class of 2026. The Session voted to proceed with ordination and installation of these officers on Sunday, January 28.

The Session Meeting then resumed.

Financial Reports/Discussions: Financial reports were discussed under the Finance Committee.

- CLERKS REPORT:
  - Correspondence: Thanks, from Pastor Cindy for the Bonus. It was appreciated.
  - Email/Text Approvals:
    - A text sent on December 20, 2023, for approval. Pastor Cindy had asked Cindy Daniels and Kathy Welch if they were willing to serve as Treasurers during 2024. Both said they would, so the Session voted to approve them serving.
    - On January 11, the text message sent to approve vacation for Pastor Cindy from January 30-February 12, 2024. She and husband will be traveling. Elders approved.
    - On January 11, a text message was sent asking for approval of the following Pastors to fill the pulpit while Pastor Cindy's on vacation as well as serve Communion. Having Rev. Ann Schwartz fill the pulpit on February 11, who is the relatively new Lead Presbyter for our Presbytery. Elders approved.
    - On January 12, a text message was sent asking for approval to cancel church services on Sunday, January 14 because of the forecasted snow and subzero weather. This was amended to include Sunday School as well as a planned Youth Group Meeting. The Session voted to approve contacting parishioners as well as the local TV Stations to get the word out.

### • **PASTOR'S REPORT:**

- Since the last Session meeting:
- <u>Transition</u>
- I have moved out of the manse with the exception of cleaning supplies, a rug cleaner, and a mixer. I have yet to clean the manse because the electricity and water were off, but they are now back on. My plan is to clean the manse this Saturday.
- I have transitioned to setting hours to work in the church office. I have my office set up to function pretty well. My biggest challenge at the moment is adjusting to getting my workout in, getting dressed and ready AND commuting in for work. Fifteen steps to work were much easier to complete in a timely manner.
- Worship
- Planned and presided over worship and home communions for Sunday mornings and for Christmas Eve.
- I am pleased to report that Sam has completed ½ of the hymnal project 1 (we know the hymn and sing it well), 2 (we kind of know the hymn and/or don't sing it often), 3 (we don't know this hymn at all) hymn. Sam has added a 4<sup>th</sup> category which are "hymns that we don't know but that he would like us to learn".

I wanted to be sure that communion would be rightly administered, and I am willing to have people direct their opinion about pulpit supply towards me, not the worship chair.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Per Capita for 2024 is \$37.25 per member, an increase of \$1.00.
- The Session voted to approve transfer of Beth and Melody Martin's membership to United Methodist in Elmwood per their request.
- The Session voted to approve the 2024 Budget as presented.
- The Session voted to have Alissa hand out a survey to see what the congregation would like in a Minister. It will be distributed by February 18 with a request to return completed forms by March 3. Alissa will then go over results and get an idea of what we should look for in a new minister.
- The Session voted to elect Pat Welker as the Clerk of Session for 2024. She informed Session that this will be her last year serving as Clerk.
- The Session voted to have meetings on the **<u>Third</u>** Thursday of each month at 6pm.
- The Session voted to approve One Great Hour of Sharing Sunday as Palm Sunday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, when the kids will march in with their palms and 'fish banks'. Special envelopes will be placed around the sanctuary for a couple weeks to collect donations.
- The Session voted to approve 4 Elders as a Session quorum.
- The Session voted to approve 20 as a Congregational Meeting quorum.
- The Session voted to approve that notification required for a congregational meeting is 2 Sundays and the meeting can be held on the Second Sunday.
- The Session voted to approve asking the congregation to allow the Session to approve the minutes of Annual and Congregational Meetings. This must then be stated in the Congregational Meeting Minutes.

- The Elders decided which Ministry Teams they wanted to be on for 2024. They are listed on each of the Committee Reports above. If you would like to help with any committee, contact one of the members.

## **Food Pantry**

The Farmington Food Pantry is open on the 3rd Wednesday of each month from 12:30pm – 1:30 pm. The Food Pantry is located at New Hope Fellowship Church 1102 N. State Route 78, Farmington, IL 61531. You do not even need to get out of your car. It is open to anyone in the Farmington area school district or who lives in Elmwood. There is no income requirement. You can now follow the Food Pantry on Facebook at Farmington IL Food Pantry.

## **Little Free Pantry**

On the east side of the CE building, just south of the door, is a Little Free Pantry that the local Girl Scouts put together. This little free pantry is open and free for anyone, anytime. Feel free to drop off any food to help keep it stocked. Also, feel free to take any food that you might need, no questions asked. This food pantry supports those in our community who might need some extra food on those days when the Food Pantry is closed.

# Per Capita 2024

The Per Capita amount for each member for 2024 is \$37.25. This is not an assessment or dues, but a covenant relationship with the greater church. This amount is not in our 2024 budget but paid as collected from each member to the Presbytery of Great Rivers.
